

Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The Telemark Nordic Club as authorized under Lands file 3408497 to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The aquifer on which the rights are granted is Peachland Bedrock.
- b) The point of well diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 18, 1990.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is commercial enterprise.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for commercial enterprise is 3 cubic meters per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is January 1 to December 31.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Leased crown land Lease No 3408497.
- h) The authorized works are well, pipe, cistern which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

k) During all phases of construction and maintenance of the licenced works and related activities, the holder of this licence is subject to the habitat protection requirements, described in the document entitled "Terms and Conditions for Construction and Maintenance of Licensed Works" (dated March 1, 2017). Those habitat protection requirements are hereby incorporated into this licence as if written herein as licence conditions, which requirements must be implemented by the licensee in conjunction with any guidance provided by a Water Manager or Habitat Officer.
