Requirements/Obligations - Exigences/obligations

This shooting range approval is valid only at the address/location shown above. Any change in address must be reported to the Chief Firearms Officer 30 days prior to the change.

The Chief Firearms Officer must be notified 30 days prior to the shooting range ceasing to operate.

This shooting range approval, including approved activities, requirements / obligations, and limitations shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the shooting range facility.

The operator of the shooting range shall maintain any licences or permits to operate issued to it by the province, municipality, township, local government or other organization in relation to operating a shooting range. If any such licence or permit is suspended, revoked or otherwise no longer valid, the shooting range must advise the Chief Firearms Officer immediately.

The operator of the shooting range shall notify, in writing, the Chief Firearms Officer of any changes to the range's executives within 30 days of the change. The following information of new range executive must be provided: His or her name, address, telephone number, and firearms licence number or, if one does not exist, his or her date of birth.

The operator of the shooting range shall ensure that only the approved shooting activities, as noted in this range approval, are conducted in the range facility by all users and that they comply with the limitations as noted in this range approval.

Any changes to the existing operating conditions that this approval has been based upon shall be made in writing to the Chief Firearms Officer. This includes changes in the hours of operation and the range safety rules. The changes can not take effect without the approval of the Chief Firearms Officer.

The operator of a shooting range shall provide written notification to the Chief Firearms Officer within 30 days of any change in the terms of any land-use or easement agreements upon which this approval was based.

The operator of a shooting range shall ensure continued compliance with regards to safety standards, requirement for users, safety training, insurance, and reporting requirements of the Shooting Clubs and Shooting Ranges Regulations.

On or before June 10, 2024 and in accordance with Section 9 of the Shooting Clubs and Shooting Ranges Regulations, the operator of the shooting range shall submit up-to-date copies of the documents set out in paragraphs 3(2)(a) to (c), as well as evidence of continuing compliance with the requirements referred to in paragraphs 3(2)(d) to (g) and sections 5 and 8, to the Chief Firearms Officer.

The range will be inspected at the discretion of the Chief Firearms Officer to ensure the range continues to meet public safety requirements and continued compliance.

Other - Autre

This range is not approved for shotgun, handgun, or center-fire rifle.

All shooting must be directed downrange towards the primary backstop.

No shooting into or toward side berms.

No cross range shooting.

All rifle shooting positions will be determined by the club.

Steel targets must be a minimum distance of 10 metres away from the shooting line for rim-fire.

Steel targets are not authorized for handguns, shotguns, or center-fire rifles.

Steel targets are to be flat and made of such material that they do not yield to the projectiles used or allowed on site. Any damaged steel must be immediately replaced or repaired.

All steel target holders must be clad in wood.

Public Agencies must adhere to the posted range rules.

Public Agencies must adhere to the shooting activities and limitations specified in this approval.

If range users of adjacent ranges are impacted or hit by shrapnel or projectile splatter/particles from the use of steel targets, then the steel targets must be shrouded.

Full automatic fire is not authorized on this range venue.
